Jesus & Mary Secondary School Gortnor Abbey Vehicle Parking Policy for Students.

Our school parking policy is designed to safeguard the health and safety of all persons on the school grounds. Safe driving habits and speed limits must always be observed.

Students are strongly discouraged from taking cars to school, however, if it is absolutely essential for a student to drive to school they must register their vehicle with the school by contacting either the Deputy Principal or Principal.

Speeding, reckless operation, making excessive noise etc. on school grounds or near any school building will not be tolerated.

Students must park in the designated area only.

Cars must be locked in the morning and must not be entered or moved during the day without official permission.

Students are not permitted to carry passengers other than siblings. Any student who uses a vehicle to transport other students will lose the privilege of parking on school grounds, unless written authorisation has been submitted to the Deputy Principal or Principal from the Parent/Guardian of the student(s) in question.

Parking on school grounds is a privilege that may be revoked on the basis of school truancy, arriving late, attendance problems or violation of these rules or of other school rules and regulations.

Cars are parked at the owners own risk. Revised 21st June 2016.
